

PRIVACY AND COOKIES POLICY

Trend IT Services LLC (“Trend IT Services”, “us”, “we”, or “our”), a company organized and existing under the laws of Ukraine, operates the “united.network” and the “https://united.network” websites and the United.Network mobile application (“Services”). This Privacy Policy (the “Privacy Policy”) is applicable between you as user of our Services (“you”, “User”) and us as operator of the Services. This Privacy Policy applies to the use of any Personal Data we collect or that you provide to us in connection with your use of the Service. This Privacy Policy aims to inform you how your Personal Data is collected, processed, used and disclosed when you use our Services. We can assure you that we comply with the European General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”) and any other applicable laws and regulations and process your personal data lawfully, fairly and transparently. We use your data to provide and improve our Services. By using the Services, you agree to the collection and use of Personal Data in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy describes how we handle your information. **We do not collect, process, or store any personal data when you use our Services.** This approach reflects our commitment to privacy by design and decentralization.

DEFINITIONS

SERVICES

Service means the https://united.network website and the United.Network mobile application operated by Trend IT Services.

PARTNER SERVICES

Partner Service means a service or feature offered by a third-party partner directly to users of the Services. External services are integrated into our platform to enhance functionality without collecting or storing user personal data.

PERSONAL DATA

Personal Data means all information that directly or indirectly identifies you (e.g., your name, first name, address, phone number, or email address, but also the IP address of your computer, for example, or the information relating to your browsing of our Website).

DEVICE INFORMATION

Device Information means Personal Data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Services or from the Services' infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a website visit).

DATA CONTROLLER

Data Controller means the natural or legal person determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal information are, or are to be, processed.

DATA PROCESSORS

Data Processor means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Data Controller.

DATA COLLECTION

We explicitly confirm that **no personal data is collected** through our platform. We do not request, retain, or process any:

- Names
- Email addresses
- IP addresses
- Identity documentation
- Payment card data or phone numbers

All services are designed for **non-custodial, privacy-respecting** operation.

PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED AUTOMATICALLY LIKE DEVICE INFORMATION / WEBSITE

COOKIES / GOOGLE ANALYTICS

When you use the Services, we do neither automatically collect nor manually any information that your browser may send, including information about your computer's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Services that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data. When you access the Services by or through a mobile device, we do neither automatically

collect nor manually any information, namely as the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device's unique ID, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

THIRD-PARTY SERVICE PROVIDERS

To provide reliable and decentralized access to blockchain services, United Network integrates the following **trusted third-party providers**:

- **Coingecko.com** – for real-time cryptocurrency prices, token metadata, and market rate feeds.
- **GetBlock.io** – as a robust RPC provider, ensuring secure, scalable blockchain connectivity and interaction without requiring to operate Blockchain nodes directly.
- **Bridgers.xyz** – providing decentralized bridging and **token-to-token swaps** via blockchain-based interoperability protocols.
- **Changelly.com** – a fiat-to-crypto and **token-to-token exchange** aggregator integrated via API for instant swap services.
- **Dtone.com** – an integrated solution enabling payment/order services or goods via Internet/e-shops/e-commerce.

These services operate autonomously and do **not transmit any personal user data** to Trend IT Services. Please consult their respective privacy policies for further details on their data handling practices.

COOKIES AND TRACKING

We do **not use tracking cookies or personal identifiers**. Only minimal technical cookies may be used to ensure platform stability and functionality. These are session-based and do not store personal data.

SECURITY PRACTICES

Although we do not handle personal data, we uphold strong cryptographic and platform security principles. All API calls and wallet interactions are protected through secure protocols, with no user data being logged or stored.

CRYPTOCURRENCY FUNCTIONALITY

United Network offers:

- **Decentralized token-to-token swaps** (via Bridgers.xyz, Changelly.com)
- **Fiat card top-ups** through third-party services
- **Cryptoprocessing infrastructure** for businesses and platforms

All integrations follow a **non-custodial, privacy-first architecture**. United Network does not monitor or control third-party KYC processes where applicable.

CUSTOMERS FROM CALIFORNIA

California law provides California customers with specific rights with regard to the collection, sale, and disclosure of their Personal Data. If you are a California resident, you have the following rights:

- The right to request that we delete any Personal Data about you that we have collected from you. Nevertheless, we will not be required to comply with your request to delete your Personal Data if it is necessary for us to maintain your Personal Data for the reasons provided under California Civil Code Section 1798.105(d).
- The right to request that we disclose to you the following:
 - (1) The categories of Personal Data we have collected about you;
 - (2) The categories of sources from which your Personal Data is collected;
 - (3) The business or commercial purpose for collecting or selling your Personal Data;
 - (4) The categories of third parties with whom the business shares your Personal Data; and
 - (5) The specific pieces of Personal Data we have collected about you.
- The right not to be discriminated against because you have exercised any of your rights under the CCPA. We do not sell your Personal Data or collect data to facilitate or enable third parties to advertise to you.
